A. FULL-TIME LECTURER POSITIONS

In Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry or Physics

Duties and Responsibilities

The successful candidates will be expected to:

- 1. Prepare and deliver lectures, tutorials, and laboratory sessions in their respective fields.
- 2. Develop, review, and update course materials and assessments to align with university standards.
- 3. Engage in research and publish in peer-reviewed journals.
- 4. Supervise undergraduate research projects and student fieldwork.
- 5. Participate actively in departmental, faculty, and University committees.
- 6. Provide academic advising, mentorship, and guidance to students.
- 7. Contribute to community outreach and other University service activities.

Minimum Qualifications and Experience

- 1. A **Master's degree** in the relevant field from a recognized institution (a **PhD** will be an added advantage).
- 2. Demonstrated experience in teaching at tertiary level.
- 3. Evidence of research engagement and/or publication record.
- 4. Excellent communication, interpersonal, and organizational skills.
- 5. Commitment to the Christian values and mission of LAMAU.

B. PART-TIME LECTURER POSITIONS

In History, Geography, or Social and Development Studies

Duties and Responsibilities

Part-time lecturers will be expected to:

- 1. Conduct lectures, tutorials, and student assessments in the assigned courses.
- 2. Prepare course outlines, learning materials, and examinations.
- 3. Ensure effective student engagement and timely marking of assessments.
- 4. Collaborate with full-time faculty in maintaining academic quality standards.

Minimum Qualifications and Experience

- A **Master's degree** in the relevant subject area (possession of a PhD or progress toward one will be an added advantage).
- At least **two years of teaching experience** at university or college level.
- Proven commitment to quality teaching and student support.

Terms of Appointment

- **Full-time positions** will be offered on a **three (3) year renewable contract**, subject to performance and institutional needs.
- Part-time appointments will be based on a yearly contract tenure renewable based on your good performance as stipulated in LAMAU's Terms and Conditions of Service.
